Moorhead Cultural Mall Project



Project Scope

- Full building reconstruction of the exterior façade and interior floor plan
- Major upgrades to structural, mechanical, electrical, HVAC and plumbing systems
- Creation of flexible market-style retail spaces for local vendors
- Build out of restaurant and food hall spaces including hoods and other necessary components
- Development of exhibit galleries, classrooms, and interactive areas
- Accessibility improvements and ADA compliance measures
- Sustainability enhancements, including energy efficiency and waste reduction
- Outdoor landscaping, lighting, and parking upgrades
- Installation of furnishings, fixtures, audio/visual equipment

State Capital Investment Request

\$3,000,000

This state funding will be crucial in executing the core renovation and construction of the Cultural Mall facility. It will cover approximately 18.5% of total project costs. The capital provided will be focused on:

- Purchase and acquisition of the formerly Wells Fargo building in downtown Moorhead
- Structural reconstruction and building systems upgrades to State & local specifications
- Utilities upgrades
- Accessibility improvements and ADA compliance
 - -Environmental considerations

The state's contribution will lay the foundation for the project. Local matching funds will support the design, demolition, reconstruction and further tenant improvements. Tenant revenue and other outside sources will fund Mall operating expenses

Total Project Cost Breakdown

- Building Acquisition: \$2.9 Million
- Design and Engineering: \$350,000
- Reconstruction and Build Out: \$10.51 Million
- Furniture, Fixtures, Equipment (FF&E): \$1.5 Million
- Contingency Reserve: \$500,000
- Financing Fees: \$540,000

Total Project Cost: \$16.3M *current estimate

IDC's Investment to Date

- Feasibility & Market Study: \$40,000
- Architect Fees: \$49,000
- Earnest Money for the Building: \$100,000
- Building Inspection: \$6,000
- Consultants: \$42,000

Total IDC Investment to Date: \$237,000
